MILL VALLEY is one of the most culturally rich small towns in the nation. It is home to the first-rate Marin Theatre Company, the prestigious Mill Valley Film Festival, the spectacular outdoor Mountain Play atop Mount Tamalpais, 142 Throckmorton Theatre, First Tuesday Artwalk and the historic Outdoor Art Club. Locals and visitors look forward to the Fall Arts Festival in September and the juried Holiday Arts Fair produced by Muir Beach Quilters in December. Millions of tourists flock year-round to view the awe-inspiring redwoods at Muir Woods national monument and to watch the surfers at STINSON Beach. For hikers and runners, the historic Dipsea Trail that runs from Old Mill Park to Stinson Beach traverses breathtaking terrain with about 2,200 vertical ascent and descent including 671 steps. Locals hang out at the Book Depot, the former railroad terminal that serves as town center. This unique community is an artist's Mecca and an art-lover's dream!
